

Bylaw Proposal Presented Jan 21, 2021

Request Change to the Job Description of the Vice Chairman of Finance

Whereas Jim Johnson learned via College for New Judges, he stated he can still perform the financial accounting and reporting, as usual, however, all references in his job description to fundraising needs to be removed for us to stay in compliance.

Whereas current Bylaws, 5.02a read:

a. Vice Chairman of Finance

Act in place of the County Chairman when the County Chairman is not available to perform duties of that office. Assist County Chairman in conducting the Financial Operations and Budget of the Executive Committee. Coordinate financial affairs that involve all party business. Prepare and present to the Executive Committee for approval, not later than the CEC Organizational meeting an annual budget for the Executive Committee. Review and approve, all methods and opportunities for meeting budgetary requirements. Project budgetary increases/forecasting over the next twelve (12) to twenty-four (24) months. Assist other officers, as needed, in the realm of financial assessments. Shall oversee the party's fundraising efforts.

Whereas the following changes are recommended, including para 5.02b:

a. Vice Chairman of Finance Administration

Act in place of the County Chairman when the County Chairman is not available to perform duties of that office. Assist County Chairman in conducting the Financial Operations and Budget of the Executive Committee. Coordinate financial affairs that involve all party business. Prepare and present to the Executive Committee for approval, not later than the CEC Organizational meeting an annual budget for the Executive Committee. Review and approve, all methods and opportunities for meeting budgetary requirements. Project budgetary increases/forecasting over the next twelve (12) to twenty-four (24) months. Assist other officers, as needed. in the realm of financial assessments. Shall oversee the party's fundraising efforts.
