Senate District conventions will be held in Denton County for each of the three Senate Districts that are represented in Denton County, namely SD 9, SD 12 and SD 30. This year, the Senate District conventions in Denton County will be held as follows:

How to Become a State Convention Delegate

Any duly elected delegate or alternate to one of the three Senate District Conventions can apply to become a delegate to the Texas Republican Party (RPT) State Convention. You must complete an application and send it to the Temporary Nominations Committee Chairman of your respective Senate District Convention. **A copy of this application can be found on this website and you can download it to your computer.** If it is too late to mail the application prior to the March 20 date for the District Conventions, make sure that you appear before your Temporary Nominations committee at the convention and submit your application.

Please note that even if you mail in an application to your Temporary Nominations Committee Chairman, you may still be required to testify before that committee if you wish to become a State Convention delegate or alternate.

The State Convention will be held in **Dallas, Texas on June 11, and June 12, 2010 at the Dallas Convention Center.**

The temporary committees that have been selected for the different Senate Districts may have a number of scheduled meetings prior to the March 20 Senate District Conventions. Normally, Nominations committees and Resolutions committees will have a number of scheduled meetings.
