


Looking up a Voters Precinct and Voting Record (GOP Data Center)





Login (ask Executive Director for password)




2. After logging in, the home page will appear.




3. Scroll down the homepage and select "Find a Voter."




4. After selecting "Find a Voter," use the options to search a voter




5. After searching, names will appear on the right hand side.




6. If the search is too broad, narrow using other options ("City" is the easiest). *Remember, less is more!




7. If the name will not come up, try eliminating the first name and searching by last name only.



8. Before selecting a name, verify the address is correct. Use the magnifying class button to open a person's account.




9. After selecting the magnifying glass, a new window will open with the voter's information. Select "Vote History" on the left hand side.



10. After selecting "Vote History," it will scroll you to the accounts voting record. Scroll up just a little to see the precinct number.
